

# Resuscitation Programs

All Aid First Aid is proud to offer a range of four high-quality, outcomes-driven resuscitation programs. These programs are highly practical and include a variety of training scenarios that demand that each participant draw on their past knowledge and engage their new skills to manage these hypothetical emergencies. Training in this practical manner exceeds all other forms of first aid training.

## **COURSE ONE – Perform CPR**

This is a two-hour program for those who have not practiced CPR and Defibrillation for some time, or at all, and wish to regain or to learn these skills anew. This course deals with the provision of basic life support techniques and management of the casualty until the arrival of medical assistance.

**Qualification** – this program awards the following nationally recognised and Work Cover approved unit of competency to participants who are deemed competent in the assessment:

+ HLTFA301B - Apply First Aid

This unit should be recertified annually to maintain competence.

## **COURSE TWO**

### **Perform CPR Refresher**

This is a one-hour program for those who wish to refresh their CPR and Defibrillation skills – this program should be undertaken no longer than one year from the date of the last assessment.

**Qualification** – this program re-certifies HLTFA301B - Apply First Aid

## **COURSE THREE**

### **Apply Advanced Resuscitation Techniques**

This is a four-hour program for those who have not practiced Advanced Resuscitation for some time, or at all, and wish to regain or to learn these skills anew. This course deals with the provision of advanced first aid resuscitation techniques, life support and management of the casualty until the arrival of medical assistance.

**Qualification** – this program awards the following nationally recognised and Work Cover approved unit of competency to participants who are deemed competent in the assessment:

+ HLTFA404A - Apply Advanced Resuscitation Techniques

This unit should be recertified annually to maintain competence.



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## **COURSE FOUR – Apply Advanced Resuscitation Techniques Refresher**

This is a two-hour program for those who wish to refresh their Advanced Resuscitation skills – this program should be undertaken no longer than one year from the date of the last assessment.

**Qualification** – this program re-certifies HLTA404A - Apply Advanced Resuscitation Techniques

**Assessment** – the above courses have two modes of assessment:

1. On-going practical assessments
2. Multiple choice examination

### **Requirements of all programs –**

participation in these resuscitation courses requires that participants have a preparedness to be on the floor practicing skills and the willingness to engage wholly in scenario-based practical sessions.

### **The practical curriculum of our Resuscitation programs includes:**

- + Management of the unconscious person
- + Management of a choking person/person with obstructed airway
- + The provision of effective CPR (Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation)
- + The safe and effective use of AEDs (Automated External Defibrillators)

### **In addition to the above, the Advanced Resuscitation curriculum includes:**

- + The use of medical grade oxygen to assist in resuscitation
- + The use of artificial airways to maintain a patent airway
- + The use of suction to clear and maintain the airway
