

# AAFA Venue Requirements

Because we provide training at your location, we need to make sure the venue is suitable. But the requirements are pretty simple.

- A room with carpet and chairs; no need for projectors or whiteboards
- Easy access to an outdoor area, preferably grassed or landscaped
- A wet weather option - a covered outdoor area is ideal

Training scenarios are messy, they are best done outside and/or somewhere out of the way:

- Workshops, gyms, halls and sheds are all suitable, especially as wet weather options
- Ideally, areas where real first aid situations have already occurred (or are likely to)

For Remote Area and Wilderness programs we need access to:

- Natural landscapes and/or bushland

All venues must have:

- Disability Access
- Fire Escapes
- Evacuation Plan
